The line is prevented from touching the slope face thanks to the tensioning system. A cleaning system and precision guide are part of the machine. Fire-resistant sheeting protects electrical components inside the tractors with heavy-duty guards protecting hydraulic cylinders and hoses. Fire plows, bush blades and winches are some of the other pieces of equipment used to combat fires. Overheating is

prevented by the direct-drive powertrain and cooling modules charge the radiator, powertrain and air. The Dressta model SB-85 is useful for realigning and repositioning conveyor belts. This unit can be utilized to move railway tracks or employed in confined locations.
